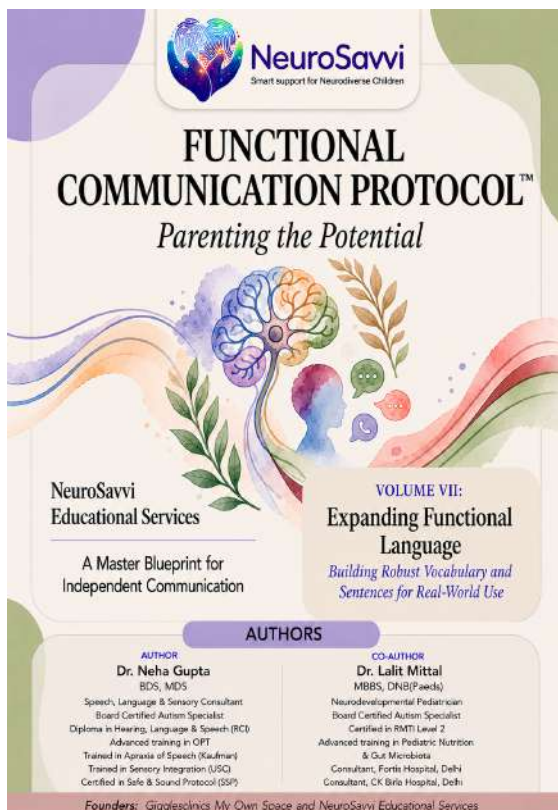

What This Volume Is About

Volume 7 develops the language required for nuanced social and real-world situations. It helps the child understand that meaning can change with tone, context, emotion and the listener's perspective.

The programme strengthens complex sentence structures, social nuance, verbal planning, problem solving, comparing, contrasting and negotiation. These are the communication skills needed for growing autonomy, academic language and self-advocacy.

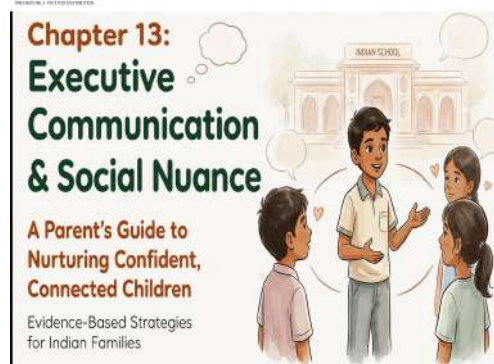

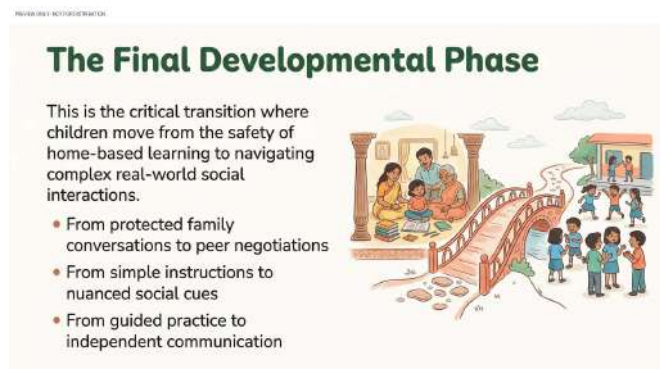
